2010 Rule Book

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Missouri Hare Scrambles Championship (MHSC) is to develop a system of competitive motorcycle Hare Scrambles in Missouri, whereby a point accumulation process will determine awards for overall and for all classes. The season will be a calendar year.

ORGANIZATION:

The organization of the MHSC will consist of a Chairman, Vice Chairman/Treasurer, Secretary, Scorekeeper, a rider's committee consisting of five (5) riders selected each year by the series officers and, one (1) representative from each sponsoring club. The four (4) officers will be elected for two (2) year terms. The Chairman and Secretary are to be elected on alternate years from the two (2) other officers. The Chairman's decision can only be overruled by a unanimous vote of the other (3) officers.

MEETINGS:

1. There will be an annual meeting prior to the start of each season. At this meeting existing rules will be reviewed and necessary changes will be made that are in the best interests of the Missouri Hare Scrambles Championship.
2. A MHSC Representative meeting can be called by the Chairman or the Vice Chairman, exclusively. All sponsoring clubs must be notified about the meeting in written form.
3. A quorum will consist of 70% of the sponsoring clubs.
4. All clubs present at the annual meeting will have one vote each. The Chairman will vote in case of a tie.
5. The five (5) person rider's committee will have one (1) vote.
6. All promoters are required to attend the annual meeting in its entirety if they wish to retain their status as an active promoter.

FINANCIAL:

Expenses for the operation of the series shall be derived from an assessment on each entry in each sponsoring club's Hare Scramble. All revenue derived shall be expended for the operation of the series and there will be no wages, salaries, nor any form of remuneration paid to any person for any duties. The Treasurer will provide a Financial Report at the annual meeting.

1. Gate Fees for an event are to be set by the sponsoring club.
2. Entry fees are to be \$30 except for an AMA National or races that pay a cash purse. Entry fees for AA riders at cash purse races will be \$45. Payback at these races must be a minimum of 75% of the AA entry fees.
3. All Pee Wee class entry fees will be \$15 per rider.
4. The promoter will pay \$3 for each entry into the MHSC fund at the end of each race day. There will be a maximum payment of \$750 for this fee. The promoter will not be assessed \$3 for the Beginner or Pee Wee classes. Payment being made to the Treasurer, Chairman or Scorekeeper.
5. There is \$2 charge per rider for all classes for special purposes and will also be paid to the MHSC on race day, with no maximum. The Pee Wee classes are exempt.
6. There will be a \$100 charge, per event for all sponsoring clubs to be paid at the annual meeting. This fee must be paid even if the sponsoring club plans to sit out that race season.

SCOREKEEPING:

1. 70% of the total number of races rounded to the nearest whole number will be used for scoring purposes.
2. All riders wishing to obtain MHSC points must request an MHSC number. That number is used to identify the rider for the entire season. If a rider does not request an MHSC number they will not accumulate season points.
3. Results from each race are to be promptly sent to the Scorekeeper. Please score top 20 overall and top 20 in each class before giving the results to scorekeeper. Results will be made available to all MHSC riders at the end of each season.
4. In the event of an end of year tie in total points, the tie will be broken by first determining which rider had the higher number of first place finishes for the entire year. If a tie still exists then the higher number of second place finishes for the entire year will be used and so forth until the tie is resolved.

5. If a rider wishes to change classes at any time during the season, he may not carry any previous points into a new class.
6. Scoring for the individuals who work an event will be as follows: The rider's best 5 scores will be totaled and divided by five (5) rounded to the nearest whole number. This result will give one additional score (work average). The rider must be present and work on the day of that race to receive a work average. Non-club members wishing to earn a work average must make arrangements with the sponsoring club not less than two weeks prior to the race date. It is up to the discretion of the promoter as to whether a work average is to be awarded to an individual.
7. The sponsoring club will create a list of individuals scheduled to have a work average and provide it to the Scorekeeper prior to the beginning of sign-up on the day of the race.
8. The points system is as follows:

9. Riders wishing to be scored must complete a lap of the race course. A rider that does not complete a full lap will not be scored for that lap. A rider that does not complete any laps of the race course will not receive a score (DNF).

10. Junior and Women riders that do not complete any laps of the race course will be awarded a score below that of the last rider that did complete a lap. (example; 6 riders are in the class, only 3 riders complete a lap, the remaining riders do not complete any laps. The last 3 riders will all receive points for a 4th place finish.). All riders must start the race to receive these points.
11. All MHSC points are awarded based on class finishing place except at an AMA National Hare Scramble. At those events MHSC riders will be put back into their regular MHSC classes. Laps and times from the event will be used to score.
12. Only MHSC AA riders may enter the AA class at an AMA National Hare Scramble. MHSC A riders must ride in one of the A classes at an AMA National Hare Scramble.
13. The AA-Expert class will consist of the top ten (10) overall. The A-Intermediate M/C class will consist of the top 11 to 25 overall. The A-Sportsman M/C class will consist of the top 26 to 40 overall.
14. Any of these AA-Expert, A-Intermediate or A-Sportsman riders who does not qualify in the top 40 riders the previous year, may ride a regular class the next year.
15. Those qualified to ride the A-Intermediate class may not ride any other class except the AA class. Those qualified to ride the A-Sportsman class may not ride any other class except the AA class or the A-Intermediate class.
16. The top three (3) riders in any C class must move up to a B class the following year.
17. Any rider in violation of rule 13, 14, 15 or 16 above will have their score removed by the Scorekeeper.
18. No rider should ride the Beginner class if they have received a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place trophy in three (3) races. No rider should ride the Beginner class more than one complete year.
19. The Beginner class and all Pee Wee classes are non-points paying MHSC classes.

GENERAL:

1. There should be a sweep crew during and after each event.
2. Toilet facilities should be provided at each race location. Please do so for the consideration of all.
3. All sponsoring clubs must allow AA-Expert, A-Intermediate and A-Sportsman to display their respective number (overall finishing place from previous year) on their numbers plate.
4. All MHSC races must be within the state of Missouri.
5. There will be no co-sanctions or any other non-MHSC related events on an MHSC race weekend unless approved at that year's planning meeting.
6. If a race is not held as scheduled, it should be clarified at that time as to whether it is postponed or canceled.
7. If a race is postponed the promoter has 30 days to reschedule. The new date must be before Thanksgiving. The date must be approved by the Chairman and all promoting clubs must be called to ensure it is a free date.
8. There will be a maximum of 16 events in one season.

EVENT:

1. Hare Scramble tracks are required to have a minimum lap length of five (5) miles with a recommended minimum length of seven (7) miles.
2. Pee Wee course(s) should consist of easy terrain and share little with the big bike course. It should be close to the pit and scoring area and if possible, an even easier and shorter course should be provided for the Pee Wee 50cc automatics.
3. The scoring trailer and scoring lanes will be placed at the start of the pit lanes.
4. Gates will open at 6:00am
5. Sign up will be from 9:00am to 11:30am. Practice will start no later than 10:00am. Riders meeting will be at 11:30am and the races will start at 12:00pm.
6. The Pee Wee race will begin after completion of the big bike race. The earliest would be 3:00pm
7. No studded tires will be allowed on the course at any time.
8. Fire extinguishers should be placed at the start and at each pit area of the race.
9. Every rider's lap time must be recorded. Each rider's finish time must be recorded in minutes and seconds.

10. All races will be two hours in length for all classes except Junior and Women; they will only race for one hour. This applies to all events except AMA Nationals.
11. All riders must stop at all checkpoints. Checkpoints should be placed in slow sections.
12. The finish line will be clearly marked before the scoring lanes.
13. The Gas Stop Marshall has the authority to stop or reroute a race for an ambulance, etc.
14. Score boards will be posted for riders viewing upon completion of each race. There will be a thirty (30) minute protest period. Results will be final unless protested within the thirty (30) minute protest period.
15. Protests must be filed in the following manner:
 - a) The protest should first be voiced to the promoter when the race results are posted and the protest period begins.
 - b) If the protest is not resolved to the racer's satisfaction, the promoter should be given a brief hand written protest before he leaves the race.
 - c) Then, the racer should prepare a formal protest to be mailed to the Chairman of the series, to be postmarked within one (1) week of the event.
 - d) The Chairman will make the determination on the protest and reply to the racer within three (3) weeks of receiving the formal protest.
 - e) If the protest is still not resolved to the racer's satisfaction, a copy of the formal protest should then be mailed to the Vice-Chairman/Treasurer, the Scorekeeper and, the Secretary within one week of receiving the Chairman's determination.
 - f) They must make a final determination on the protest within three (3) weeks of receiving the formal protest.
16. The start of each race will be a dead engine, rider on or off the bike. The starter will use a large card with a number 30 on it. This means 30 seconds or less remaining before the start of the race. He will drop the card for the start.

17. The promoter can penalize any rider for being more than twenty five (25) feet off the marked course.
18. A rider must stay between any double arrow marking on the course.
19. Any rider caught cutting the course should be docked a minimum of one (1) lap.
20. A rider may not switch bikes during the race.
21. The starting order of each event will be as follows: AA-Expert always 1st, A-Intermediate always 2nd, A-Sportsman always 3rd. OpenB, 250B, 200B, Veteran and the Senior class will be rotated at each race. The rotation order is determined at the beginning of each race season by the Scorekeeper. Next in the starting order is the Super Senior and Masters, OpenC, 250C, 200C, Junior/Women and the Beginner class will start last.
22. All riders except those in the Beginner class must wear a colored stripe on the rear of their helmet. The color will correspond to the class the rider is entered in for that event. Colored stripes will be available at signup at each event. If a rider does not display a colored stripe, they will have to line up with the Beginner class at that event. Colors for each Motorcycle class are listed on pages 8 in the list of classes.
23. Verbal and physical abuse between riders and/or crewmembers will not be tolerated. While a certain amount of rubbing is expected in racing, intentionally ramming, t-boning, or any other takeout move is unacceptable. Any such conduct will result in an immediate disqualification from the event. If a rider is involved in such behavior on a second occasion, all points earned to-date will be lost. If there is yet a third occurrence, the rider will be removed from the series altogether.
